System Brings Period of Snow and Brief Mix on January 18-19

Start: 5 - 7 PM January 18th **End:** 2 - 4 AM January 19th

Snow moved into the area between 5 - 7 PM January 18th becoming a steady light to briefly moderate snow through Midnight. Temperatures initially in the low-mid 20's briefly warmed to 27 - 32 and mixed with a few sleet pellets and patchy freezing rain/drizzle as it ended 2 - 4 AM January 19th.

System Brings Period of Snow and Brief Mix on January 18-19

Start: 5 - 7 PM January 18th **End:** 2 - 4 AM January 19th

Snow moved into the area between 5 - 7 PM January 18th becoming a steady light to briefly moderate snow through Midnight. Temperatures initially in the mid 20's briefly warmed to 31 - 35 after Midnight and mixed with some rain and sleet before temperatures fell back to 28 - 32 with the shifting wind. This caused some areas to mix with patchy freezing rain/drizzle as precipitation ended 2 - 4 AM January 19th.

Start: 5 - 7 PM January 18th **End:** 11 PM January 18th - 1 AM January 19th

Snow moved into the area between 5 - 7 PM January 18th becoming a steady light to briefly moderate snow. Temperatures initially in the low-mid 20's warmed to 32 - 34 degrees, causing a mix with rain and some sleet as it ended 11 PM January 18th - 1 AM January 19th.
