

## Massachusetts: December 5th - 6th, 2020

### Intervals of Rain, Snow and Sleet December 5-6

**Start:** 3 - 5 PM December 5th    **End:** 12 - 2 AM December 6th

Moderate to heavy steady rain developed overnight and into the early morning hours on December 5th. Steady rain then continued through the morning and afternoon. At this point, wet snow began to mix in with rain before transitioning to light to moderate persistent wet snow between 3 - 5 PM December 5th as temperatures cooled from 37-40 degrees to 33-35 degrees. The light steady wet snow briefly continued before rain and some sleet mixed back in with the wet snow between 6-8PM. This mix of rain, wet snow, and some sleet continued into the night before lightening in intensity before finally tapering off between 12 - 2 AM December 6th.

Moderate to heavy steady rain developed overnight and into the early morning hours on December 5th. Steady rain then continued through the morning and afternoon. At this point, wet snow began to mix in with rain before transitioning to light persistent wet snow between 3 - 5 PM December 5th. The light steady wet snow briefly continued before temperatures warmed back to 36-38 degrees between 6-8PM allowing rain and some sleet to mix back in with the wet snow. This mix of rain, snow, and sleet continued into the night before finally tapering off between 10 PM December 5th - 12 AM December 6th.
