

Massachusetts: January 14th - 16th, 2023

Coastal System Rotates Periods of Snow and a Wintry Mix into the Region on January 15-16

Start: 11 AM - 2 PM January 15th **End:** 2 - 5 PM January 16th

After some morning flurries, a system off the southeast coast of New England began to bring in a few periods of light to briefly moderate snow beginning 11 AM - 2 PM January 15th, with temperatures 33-36 degrees. Temperatures dipped to 30-32 degrees after sunset with periods of mainly light snow tapering to intermittent snow showers and flurries by around midnight. An occasional shower and flurries lingered overnight until steadier periods of precipitation developed around sunrise. Activity briefly fell as some freezing rain and sleet before transitioning to plain snow again by mid morning with temperatures rising to 32-34 degrees. On and off periods of light snow eventually tapered off by 2 - 5 PM January 16th. Wind gusts during the event were 20 - 30 MPH

Coastal System Rotates Periods of Snow and a Wintry Mix into the Region on January 15-16

Start: 11 AM - 2 PM January 15th **End:** 4 - 7 PM January 16th

After some morning flurries, a system off the southeast coast of New England rotated areas of snow (locally heavy) beginning between 11 AM - 2 PM January 15th, with temperatures falling from 33-36 to 28-32 degrees. Following this first period, the snow overall was on the light side overnight into the 16th as brief breaks in precipitation developed, allowing for sleet and freezing rain to mix in. The periods of light wintry mix transitioned back to mainly snow after daybreak on the 16th. After 2 or 3 PM, steadier snow tapered to a lingering intermittent wintry mix which finally exited by 4 - 7 PM January 16th, with temperatures between 32-34 degrees. Wind gusts during the event were 25 - 35 MPH

Slow Moving Coastal System Brings Prolonged Wintry Event on January 14-16

Start: 11 PM January 14th - 2 AM January 15th **End:** 2:30 - 5:30 PM January 16th

Intermittent light snow showers and flurries began between 11 PM January 14th - 2 AM January 15th, with temperatures beginning between 33-36 degrees. Activity continued on and off overnight before giving way to steadier periods of light to moderate snow by midday on the 15th as temperatures gradually dipped to 31-34 degrees thereafter. Steady snow turned lighter once again while continuing overnight and into the 16th. Around sunrise on the 16th, a few breaks in the snow developed which allowed some rather light sleet and pockets of freezing drizzle to briefly mix in. Otherwise, periods of light snow resumed by mid morning turning moderate at times again towards midday before tapering to flurries by 2:30 - 5:30 PM January 16th. Winds occasionally to 30 - 40 MPH during the event.
