Rain Ends as Intermittent Snow on January 20-21

Start: 11 AM - 2 PM January 20th **End:** 5 - 8 AM January 21st

Periods of overnight rain changed intermittent light snow 11 AM - 2 PM January 20th, with temperatures 33-36 degrees. On and off intermittent light snow turned more showery while continuing overnight, eventually tapering by 5 - 8 AM January 21st. Temperatures gradually cooled off overnight to 32-34 degrees.

Rain Ends as Periods of Snow on January 20-21

Start: 8 - 11 AM January 20th **End:** 2 - 5 AM January 21st

After some non accumulating snow/sleet mixed with rain at onset on the 19th, periods of overnight rain changed to periods of light to occasionally moderate snow beginning 8 - 11 AM January 20th, with temperatures 33-36 degrees. As temperatures dipped to 32-34 degrees in the evening snow tapered to intermittent light showers or flurries towards midnight. A few showers lingered at times before finally exiting by 2 - 5 AM January 21st.

Long-Duration Storm Features Rain to Snow January 20-21

Start: 12 - 3 AM January 20th **End:** 3 - 5 AM January 21st

With temperatures 35 - 40 degrees, precipitation arrived 1:30 - 3:00 PM January 19th as a mix of rain and sleet. This quickly went to all rain, which continued through evening. Then, between 12 - 3 AM January 20th, rain changed to a brief (but heavy in spots) period of wet snow and sleet with temperatures 33 - 35 degrees. This produced a light accumulation. Thereafter, occasional periods of flurries and light snow occurred (with a little rain mixed back in). Late in the morning on the 20th, steadier batches of snow returned and while it was not as heavy as before, the snow did fall moderately at times through the rest of the day. Temperatures stayed 33 - 35 degrees during the daytime. The steadiest snow turned lighter in the evening while tapering to intermittent showers which lingered at times until 3 - 5 AM January 21st, with temperatures dipping to 29 - 32.
