A Fluffy Snow on February 25th

Start: 3 - 4:30 PM February 25th **End:** 7:30 - 9:30 PM February 25th

Light snow arrived 3 - 4:30 PM February 25th and cold temperatures allowed for immediate accumulation. The snow was fluffy and it tapered in the evening, generally ending 7:30 - 9:30 PM (just a few flurries remained thereafter). Temperatures were 16 - 20 degrees.

Most places saw a light to moderate snow for at least a couple hours and the snow was fluffy. It quickly tapered in the evening, generally ending 7:30 - 9:30 PM (just a few flurries remained thereafter). Temperatures were 17 - 22 degrees.
