

Massachusetts: March 3rd - 5th, 2023

Mixed Rain, Snow, and Sleet on March 3-5

Start: 11 PM March 3rd - 2 AM March 4th **End:** 9 PM March 4th - 12 AM March 5th

A period of light snow mixed with some pockets of light rain and sleet developed between 11 PM March 3rd - 2 AM March 4th, with temperatures between 34-37 degrees. In the predawn activity changed to mainly rain which occasionally mixed with some sleet pellets at times through the day on the 4th, limiting accumulations with temperatures near 40. Colder air began to filter in aloft on the backside of the system allowing mixed precipitation to end as some light snow showers after 3-6PM, with temperatures falling to 33-36 degrees. Light scattered snow showers tapered off by 9 PM March 4th - 12 AM March 5th as temperatures dipped to near 32 degrees.

Mixed Rain, Snow, and Sleet on March 3-5

Start: 11 PM March 3rd - 2 AM March 4th **End:** 9 PM March 4th - 12 AM March 5th

A period of light snow mixed with some pockets of light rain and sleet developed between 11 PM March 3rd - 2 AM March 4th, with temperatures between 34-38 degrees. While pockets of mixed snow/sleet continued to occur through 9 PM March 4th - 12 AM March 5th, a majority of the accumulation ended towards dawn on the 4th as rain mixed in more frequently. Any mix of sleet and rain resulted in a denser than normal accumulation.

A Large System Brings Mixed Snow, Rain, and Sleet on March 3-4

Start: 10 PM March 3rd - 12 AM March 4th **End:** 5 - 7 PM March 4th

As a large system approached from the southwest, steady light to briefly moderate snow developed 10 PM March 3rd - 12 AM March 4th. By 3-5 AM, snow mixed with plain rain and sleet as temperatures remained between 34-38 degrees, resulting in a denser than normal accumulation. Rain mixed with sleet and some snow at times through the morning as winds began to gust to 30-35 mph. Some cooler air began to filter in aloft allowing for snow to occur more frequently in the afternoon before turning more showery and tapering off by 5 - 7 PM March 4th.
