

Massachusetts: March 14th - 15th, 2023

Rain Changed to Snow on March 14-15

Start: 5 - 7 PM March 14th **End:** 1 - 4 AM March 15th

Heavy rain occurred from the morning of March 14th lightened in the afternoon. A few wet snowflakes mixed in at times after 4PM, otherwise changed to all snow beginning 5 - 7 PM March 14th. Light to briefly moderate snow followed in the evening, before tapering to a few snow showers by Midnight. Any activity ended by 1 - 4 AM March 15th, with just a few flurries afterwards. Temperatures were 33 – 37 during the event, and winds gusted up to 35 – 45 mph.

Rain Changed to Snow on March 14-15

Start: 3 - 5 PM March 14th **End:** 1 - 4 AM March 15th

Heavy rain from the overnight continued into the daytime of March 14th. Into the afternoon, rain lightened, and mixed with occasional snow. Mainly beginning 3 - 5 PM March 14th, this changed to all snow, which continued light to moderately into the evening. By Midnight, snow tapers to snow showers, which mainly ended by 1 - 4 AM March 15th. Just a few flurries lingered thereafter. Temperatures were 33 – 36 degrees during any snow, and winds gusted up to 30 - 40 mph during the event.

Rain Changed to Snow on March 14-15

Start: 12 - 2 PM March 14th **End:** 1 - 4 AM March 15th

Rain from the overnight continued into the morning. Beginning 12 - 2 PM March 14th, rain began to mix with snow, and briefly turned to all snow. This quickly lightened as a light rain / snow mix continued into the afternoon with temperatures still holding 33 - 37 degrees. Snow struggle to accumulate during this time. Closer to sunset and afterwards, periods of light to occasionally moderate snow occurred, resulting in additional accumulation into the overnight. By Midnight, this lessened to snow showers, which mainly ended by 1 - 4 AM March 15th. Just a few flurries lingered thereafter as temperatures held 33 - 36 degrees. Winds gusted up to 35 - 45 mph during the event.
