

## Massachusetts: February 13th, 2024

### Coastal Storm Grazes the Area February 13th

**Start:** 10 - 11:30 AM February 13th    **End:** 1:30 - 3 PM February 13th

Rain began towards sunrise and continued into the morning hours with temperatures in the mid-upper 30s. Occasional snow mixed in, before turning to all snow between 10 - 11:30 AM February 13th. From there, a brief wet snow fell into the midday hours as temperatures settled to 32 - 35 degrees. Snow then quickly ended 1:30 - 3 PM. Winds gusted up to 30 - 40 mph at times.

### Coastal Storm Brings Wet Snow on February 13th

**Start:** 9 - 11 AM February 13th    **End:** 3 - 4 PM February 13th

Rain began just before sunrise and continued into the morning hours with temperatures in the mid-upper 30s. By 9 - 11 AM February 13th, rain mixed and changed to snow, which fell at a moderate to heavy intensity into the midday and afternoon. With temperatures settling to 32 - 35 degrees, it produced a wetter, dense accumulation. Snow then ended 3 - 4 PM. Winds during the event gusted up to 30 - 40 mph.

### Coastal Storm Grazes the Area February 13th

**Start:** 6 - 8 AM February 13th    **End:** 1 - 2:30 PM February 13th

Precipitation began between 6 - 8 AM February 13th as combinations of rain and snow. This variability continued into the morning with temperatures in the mid-30s, then changed to all snow by 10AM as temperatures settled to 32 - 34 degrees. A wet snow fell with brief moderate intensity into the midday, before quickly ending by 1 - 2:30 PM.
