

Massachusetts: February 15th - 16th, 2025

Large System Brings A Wintry Mix Then Rain on February 15-16

Start: 4 - 6 PM February 15th **End:** 6 - 8 AM February 16th

As a large system approached the region from the southeast, periods of light snow developed 4 - 6 PM February 15th, with temperatures 25 - 29 degrees. Snow turned briefly moderate at times while persisting into the night, as temperatures gradually increased to 30 - 32 degrees. Warm air mixed in aloft allowing the snow to mix with sleet and change to mainly freezing rain after 3 or 4 AM. Temperatures increased to 33 - 36 degrees 6 - 8 AM February 16th, changing freezing rain to plain rain. Plain rain continued throughout the day, falling heavy at times.

Large System Brings A Wintry Mix Then Rain on February 15-16

Start: 4 - 6 PM February 15th **End:** 5 - 7 AM February 16th

As a large system approached the region from the southeast, periods of mainly light snow developed 4 - 6 PM February 15th, with temperatures 25 - 29 degrees. Warm air mixed in aloft allowing the snow to mix with sleet and change to mainly freezing rain after 12 or 1 AM. Periods of freezing rain lingered mixing with plain rain in spots as temperatures increased to 31 - 33 degrees. Any pockets of freezing rain that remained changed to plain rain by 5 - 7 AM February 16th as temperatures increased to 34 - 38 degrees.

Large System Brings A Wintry Mix Then Rain on February 15-16

Start: 4 - 6 PM February 15th **End:** 6 - 8 AM February 16th

As a large system approached the region from the southeast, periods of light snow developed 4 - 6 PM February 15th, with temperatures 25 - 29 degrees. Snow turned occasionally moderate in the late evening which continued at times overnight, as temperatures gradually increased to 30 - 32 degrees. Warm air mixed in aloft allowing the snow to mix with sleet and pockets of freezing rain before changing to plain rain by 6 - 8 AM February 16th. Temperatures increased to 33 - 35 degrees to end the event. Plain rain continued throughout the day, falling heavy at times. While not accumulating, rain briefly mixed with some wet non issue snow flakes while tapering off in the evening.
